Smoking

We comply with health and safety regulations and the Welfare Requirements of the EYFS in making our setting a no-smoking environment - both indoor and outdoor.

Procedures

- We display no-smoking signs.
- Staff are prohibited to smoke during working hours, unless on a break and off the premises either at home or in the designated area and have changed out of their uniform or covered up so no odours linger on them.
- If staff smoke during their break every effort must be made to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues. If necessary clothes are to be changed and breath freshened
- After smoking staff will wash their hands when returning to the setting
- If parents are seen smoking outside the setting they are requested to use the designated area
- Vapes are not permitted to be used or charged in the setting
- Tobacco/Vape products must be stored in individuals personal bags and are not permitted in the play rooms
- If products are stored in coat pockets these **MUST** be removed before entering the play rooms
